1. Who is responsible for managing my information?

We are responsible for the collection and proper management of any personal information you submit. We will keep your personal details secure and use the information you provide consistently with applicable privacy and data protection laws and the terms of this Privacy Policy. 2. What information do we collect?

Certain areas of the website are inaccessible without retrieving some personal details from you. Some of the details we may collect are below:

3. How do we use your information?

- For Installers: Where applicable and when you have provided us with consent to be added to our installer network database, Luxusheat Ltd will pass your details to appropriate leads which may arise.
- For Customers: Where applicable and when you have requested for us to do so, Luxusheat Ltd will share your details with trusted installers in the local area.
